You may receive a phone call from our support staff to book your appointment, or receive a text message advising that you have been registered and can now book online. There may be a delay due to periods of high demand. If vaccine supply is limited we may put registration of new patients on hold – please check the home page of our website for updates.

Booking for your vaccination implies that you are prepared to consent for this. If you have questions, please book a regular appointment with your normal GP first.

If you are not eligible by virtue of your AGE you must bring confirmation of eligibility to your vaccine appointment if you are in any of the groups below:

- occupational eligibility (proof of this). Includes aged 16 and over health care workers, quarantine worked plus household contacts, border control worker plus household contacts, residential aged care workers and residents, disability workers.
- pregnancy (you need a letter from your regular GP confirming current pregnancy. Planning pregnancy or currently breastfeeding are not eligible.)
- Aged 12-59, medically eligible and NOT one of our regular patients (you need a letter from your regular GP confirming your eligibility)
- 60 and over and have a contra indication to the AstraZeneca vaccine – please discuss this with your regular GP – we will need written confirmation of eligibility from Victorian Specialist Immunisation Services - VicSIS - in order to administer the vaccine. Please speak with your GP PRIOR to booking your appointment for your vaccine.

If you had your first Covid Vaccine dose elsewhere, we are able to provide your second dose but please check which brand of vaccine you were given for your first dose. Your second dose **MUST** be the same brand (the Australian TGA has not approved mixed brand dosing). Please ensure you are booked in for the same vaccine brand as your first dose AND bring evidence of first dose brand to your appointment.
